

VISITATION GUIDELINES

CMS introduced new guidelines for Visitation which will allow all visitors access to residents and patients! Visitation is allowed to any and all who wish to visit, as long as infection control practices are strictly adhered to.

Below are highlights of the CMS guidance:

- **Masks** must be worn at all times.
- Every visitor **MUST** be screened in at the Reception desk prior to visiting your loved one.
- As of 1/12/22, NYSDOH requires all visitors to present a negative COVID test prior to visiting residents or patients.
- **Visiting hours** are Monday-Friday, 8a.m.-8p.m. and Saturday & Sunday 10a.m.-6p.m.
- **Social distancing** should be maintained during visitation.
- **If a visitor is not vaccinated**, they may visit but will be asked to wear full PPE, including mask, shield & gown.
- **Children are permitted to visit residents & patients of Meadowbrook.** However, if a child is not vaccinated, they must wear full PPE and visitation must occur in the dining room. If a child is vaccinated, they are permitted to visit residents & patients in the same manner as a vaccinated adult.
- **If a resident is in isolation** due to COVID exposure, visitors are still welcome to visit, but will be asked to wear additional PPE upon being screened in at Reception.
- **If a resident is in isolation**, visitors must wear a face shield, mask and gown at all times during their visit.
